Topic #1 - Enemy Aliens/Racism (Pages 18 - 20, 31 and hand out)

Statement - Be it Resolved that Racism and Discrimination was justified during the Great War.

- Consider what the War Measures Act Was
- Consider why we did not let some people fight during this time in our history
- Consider who should have been allowed to fight

Topic #2 - Conscription (Pages 31 - 33)

Statement - Be it Resolved that Conscription shattered Canadian unity during the First World War.

- Consider who was for and against conscription
- Consider when and why it was enforced
- Consider positives and negatives

Topic #3- Women's Franchise and Right to Participate in Politics (Page 23, 65 - 66)

Statement - Be it Resolved (in the Year 1916) that all Women Should Have the Right to Vote and Participate in the Government of our Nation.

- Consider when women got the right to vote and why
- Consider why women should not be given the right to vote
- Consider their rights during this time period
